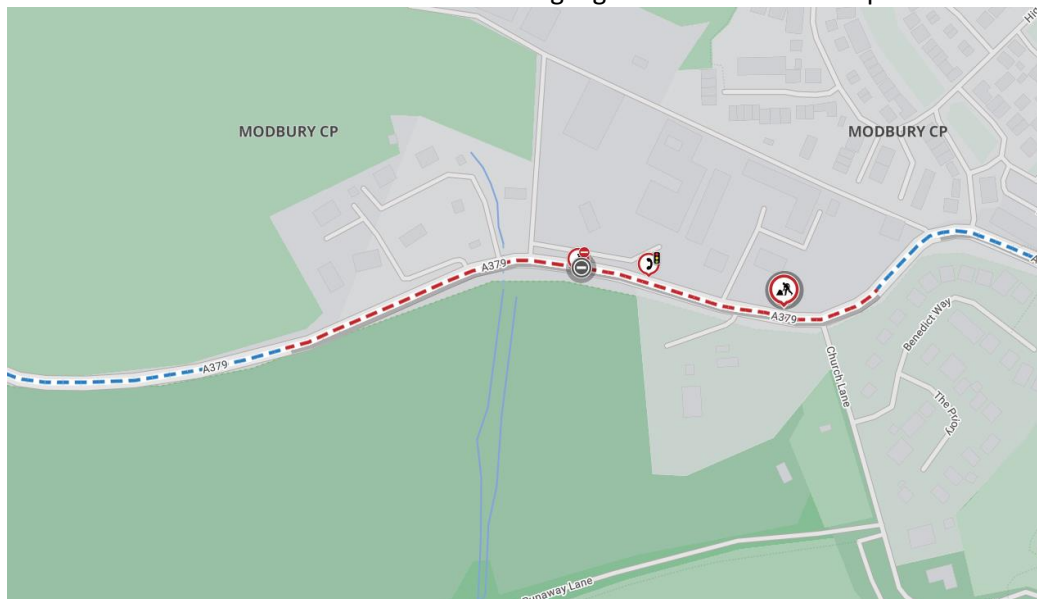
This letter is to give you some information about the forthcoming resurfacing works on the A379 on the outskirts of Modbury.


Due to the nature of the works an overnight road closure is required and the diversionary route for traffic will be signposted and advance signs will also be placed on the Highway. Emergency access will be maintained, although delays must be expected. There will be gate people to assist along with advanced warning signs. There will be a large number of signs throughout the site and on the official diversion.

The planned on-site working hours will be.

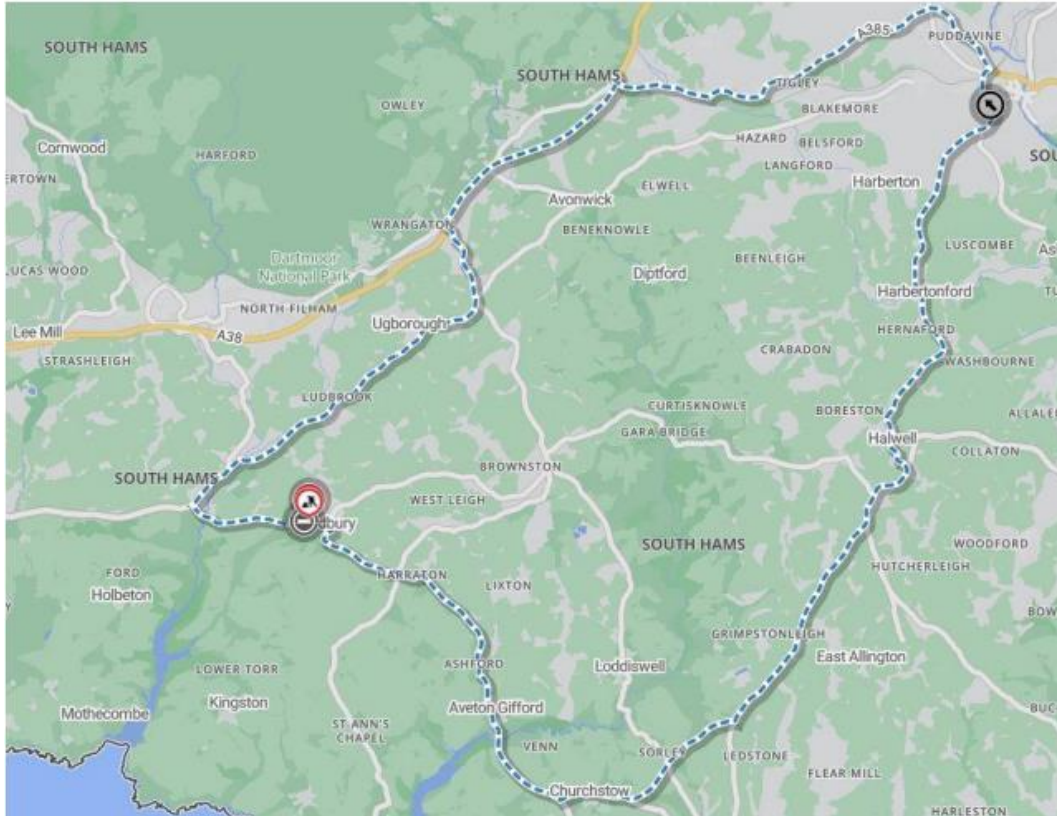
- Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February to Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February between 1900hrs and 0700hrs  
The A379 between Fancy Cross to Church Lane Modbury will be resurfaced and any related ironwork will be reset. Finally new road studs and relining will complete the works.
